The information was informative and of particular interest – and how CTC could potentially partner with these prevention efforts – was the concept of a “mocktail” campaign facilitated by establishments selling and serving alcohol in which pregnant females would be given courtesy non-alcoholic drinks as a reminder that drinking alcohol during pregnancy is unhealthy and potentially unsafe for the unborn child.
